Athlete Nomination Information

Eligibility for Nomination

- The nominee must be or will be at least 35 years old during the year of nomination.
- The nominee must been raised (attended elementary, middle and/or secondary school) in the city of Madison or have been a city of Madison resident during the period of outstanding sports achievement. University/college attendance in the city of Madison alone does not satisfy the residency requirement.
- The nominee must have distinguished herself/himself by superior accomplishments in a sport or sports at multiple levels of competition at both the amateur (high school, collegiate and Olympics) and/or professional level. The individual should have success in her/his athletic career shown by cumulative statistics, awards and longevity in a sport or sports.
- The nominee must have generally conducted herself/himself in a respectable manner on and off the playing surface and have been a positive influence in the community.
- The nominee must be retired or inactive from active sport competition for one year or, if active, must be at least 50 years old.
- The nominee may be deceased.

General Information for Nomination

- An individual, club, association, or the MSHF Club's Nominating Committee can submit a nomination that must be on the designated application form.
- The nomination form must be signed by the nominee (a relative if the nominee is deceased) as well as by the nominator.
- Nominations should outline as much information as possible giving details of the nominee's accomplishments. Whenever possible, documentary evidence supporting the individual's accomplishments should be included with the nomination form.
- Only nominations <u>on the designated application form</u> can be submitted to the Awards Chairperson in person or the form can be sent to Awards Chairperson, Madison Sports Hall of Fame Club, 2541Chamberlain Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin 53705.
- The nomination deadline for each year is 5:00 p.m. on September 15.
- If the nomination does not meet the required criteria, the nominator will be notified and the application will be returned for correction.
- If the nominee is not inducted at the annual selection meeting, the nominator will be notified by letter by approximately November 15.
- Nominations are valid for a period of five years. If a person is not selected for induction in that period, a new nomination form must be submitted for that individual to be considered for possible induction to the Hall.
